**Announcement: 2010 Summer in China Program**

**Valparaiso University's China Center** invites students of all majors to apply for the *2010 Summer in China Program*. The Program offers VU undergraduate and graduate students an opportunity to travel to and inside China, take up to six credits, intern in a Chinese institution for five and half weeks during Summer I of 2010 with up to \$800 subsidy in lodging and travel. **Itinerary:** Participants leave from Chicago to Shanghai on May 17 and return from Beijing to Chicago on June 22, 2010. The program includes a four weeks (Monday through Friday) full-time internship in a Chinese institution, a two-day weekend trip to Shanghai, a two-day weekend trip to Yellow Mountain, and a three-day trip to Beijing at the end of the Program. Other classes are offered in the evenings.

**Cost:** Valparaiso University summer tuition (based on the number of the credit hours taken with a minimum of 2 credits), international travel (\$1,100 to \$1,200), meals (about \$200-\$350), a \$450 study center fee which covers visa application and other expenses. **The China Center will cover the costs of all hotel lodging in China, the two-day trip to Shanghai, and the three-day trip to Beijing along with internship-related expenses (local transportation, cell phone, etc.).**

**Enrollment:** The enrollment is **limited to 20. The enrollment is open until all seats are filled.**

**Language Requirement:** No formal language requirement. However, if you are not a student of Chinese language, you are required to take a non-credit, *Evening Spoken Chinese* class in spring 2010.

**Application:** To apply, please complete the pre-registration form with the approval from academic advisor. The form can also be downloaded from the announcement section of CJSP's website: <http://www.valpo.edu/chineseandjapanesestudies/index.php>. Dr. Schaefer and Dr. Trapp will conduct interviews upon receiving the applications. All accepted candidates are required to attend several pre-departure orientation sessions. The formal registration will be completed in April 2010.
