Airport Arrival and Departure

In Santiago, you are required to pay a \$140 visa reciprocity fee (valid for the life of your passport). This fee must be paid at the booth located next to immigration (cash or credit card) prior to entering the line for immigration. After clearing customs, exit to the left and look for someone holding a sign reading Valparaiso University. A bus will transport participants to Vina del Mar (approximately a one-hour drive) and to the airport for the flight to Buenos Aires.

At the Buenos Aires airport, you are required to pay a \$140 visa reciprocity fee (valid for the life of your passport). Then you will need to exit customs, walk past the radio taxi booths, exit through the doors, and look for someone holding a sign reading Valparaiso University. A bus will be available for transport to the apartment hotel. If your flight is significantly delayed or you miss the bus for some other reason, hail a taxi from one of the radio taxi booths. The cost is about \$35 and credit cards are accepted. Remember to only use radio taxis in Buenos Aires.

Transportation to the airport will be provided for departure on July 1. If you plan to stay longer in Buenos Aires, you will need to make arrangements for transportation to the airport.
