Indiana Bar Exam

The two-day Bar exam contains 3 components:

(1) Two 90-minute Multi-State Performance Test (MPT) questions: “Closed universe” practical problem using instructions, factual data, cases, statutes and other reference material supplied by examiners.

(2) Six or seven essay questions selected from the following subjects:

Administrative Law	Family Law
Agency	Evidence
Commercial Law	Real Property
Constitutional Law (Federal)	Partnerships
Constitutional Law (Indiana)	Personal Property
Contracts	Taxation
Corporations	Torts
Criminal Law, Criminal Procedure	Wills and Trusts
Pleading and Practice	

(3) The Multi-State Bar Exam (MBE) consisting of 200 multiple choice questions dealing with universal laws across the states.

The three tests will be weighted as follows: MPT 20%, Indiana Essay Exam 30%, MBE 50%. The passing score will be a combined scaled score of 264.
