

## STATEMENT OF RECIPROCITY

The Career Planning Center of Valparaiso University Law School is pleased to offer reciprocity to students and graduates of other ABA accredited law schools on the following terms:

- (1) Reciprocal career services are available to students and graduates of other ABA accredited law schools that agree to provide similar services to students and graduates of Valparaiso University Law School.
- (2) Reciprocity requests must be submitted by the Career Services office of the student or graduate's ABA accredited law school. Please send request via fax (219-465-7914) or email to [tina.duron@valpo.edu](mailto:tina.duron@valpo.edu) attention Tina Duron, Career Planning.
- (3) Reciprocity services will be granted for two months from the date of the reciprocity-granting letter. On-line access to the Career Planning Center's career management system, Strategy, will be for 60 days only. Alumni or students granted reciprocity will be given a password to access Strategy.
- (4) Reciprocity services do not include individual counseling, resume/cover letter review or participation in job fairs or recruiting programs.
- (5) Reciprocity will not be available between August 1 and November 1, due to the fall on-campus interview program.
- (6) The Career Planning Center staff reserves the right to deny services to any individual who misuses the facilities or services.
