REPORT A CONCERN AND GET SUPPORT

Students who wish to report an incident of sexual misconduct may seek assistance from staff listed as "Non-Confidential Resources." The staff will protect your privacy by limiting the people with whom they share what you tell them; however, they cannot guarantee complete confidentiality, as they must notify the Title IX Coordinator.

The University will attend to your immediate needs for safety and interim measures (e.g., no contact orders, housing and academic accommodations, counseling etc.). For additional support and information about options and resources, you are encouraged to contact the Prevention and Wellness Office located in the Fitness Center.

HOW TO REPORT

Report of file a complaint with:

- Title IX Coordinator
- Dean of Students
- Valparaiso University Police

A criminal complaint and investigation does not relieve the University of its obligation to respond to an incident of sexual misconduct. You may choose to file a University complaint, a criminal complaint, both, or neither. If you choose to file a criminal complaint through the Valparaiso City Police, Valparaiso University Police will provide you with support throughout the process.
